- **Transportation:** Buses will drop off and pick up in front of school. Car riders can be dropped off or picked up in 3 different areas: Either the front of the school **ONLY** after 7am or after 2:30 pm (as buses are there before both times), by the Student Center (SC) building entering from Colony Road by the tennis courts, or in the back of the school entering from Runnymede. The gate on Mustang Way is locked in the morning to prevent traffic on campus.

- **Parking lot gates are locked during school.** Access the front of the school during this time to pick up or drop off a student.

- **Attendance Office** is in the back of the main office. If a student is unexcused tardy, scan the QR code posted on building doors around campus, then go to class. If a student has an excused tardy such as an appointment, go inside to the attendance office to get a pass and drop off a note. Parents do not need to accompany the student. If you need an early dismissal, stop in the attendance office before school starts with a note to get a pass out of class at the time of your dismissal. The note must have the student's name, ID number and a phone number where a parent/guardian can be reached between 7:00 AM and 9:00 AM. If a parent/guardian cannot be reached, the early dismissal will not be granted. No early dismissals will be granted by phone. You can upload reasons for a tardy or absence on the MPHS website. **Early dismissals can be no later than 1:45 pm.**

- **PowerSchool** is an online web-based portal to check grades and attendance. If you need help accessing or creating your parent PowerSchool account, contact Meg Bombien at margarets.bombien@cms.k12.nc.us. To troubleshoot PowerSchool, as well as NCEdCloud, Canvas, Chromebooks, and more, go to the MPHS website, click on Technology Resources at the Park on the left side.
- **Chromebooks** are given to each student during the first week of school. Students are assigned a specific Chromebook identifiable by serial number and CMS asset tag number. Students are not encouraged to share devices or chargers. Students should bring their school-issued Chromebook to school every day fully charged. If assistance is needed with a Chromebook, please complete the form, bit.ly/CBrepairhelp, and Ms. Bombien will respond via school and/or personal email with next steps. Charges will be incurred for damaged or lost devices.
- All freshmen take one **PE** class. PE uniforms are required and will be discussed the first week of class.
- MPHS does not have lockers, bring a sturdy bookbag to carry everything! Consider a water bottle!
- There are 7 minutes between classes. **Lunch** is by 3rd block, by building, 6 different time slots, 25 minutes. Eat at the picnic tables, or inside the large or small cafeteria.
