#### 2. Principal Report – Bob Folk

- a. Update regarding recent death of a MPHS student. Reiterated his continued commitment to the student body, parents, staff and MPHS during this time.
  - i. 5 students lost to suicide in 2 years (all have been 10<sup>th</sup> graders except one, and all had commonalities)
  - ii. Statistically unusual and is a growing concern for Leadership & Staff.
  - iii. Working with the Mental Health Committee, Counseling department and outside resources to assist students on how to move forward;
    - a. Focus on promoting mental health awareness, emotional well-being (both student & staff), introducing school-wide SEL time during homeroom, recorded video shared with students during school, "Connect Ed" communications sent out for parents, continued "open door" policy with staff, parents & students to continue dialogue, also asking for suggestions/perspectives on what MPHS can do "better"
- b. MPHS 2022-2023 <u>School Performance Presentation</u>
  - i. High Level Summary -
    - 1. Please see attached PPT for specific data points on Student Numbers & Performance -
    - 2. 3442 students as of today (lower than expected as some students transferred to South Meck)
    - 3. 1000 Students in Freshman class this year
    - 4. Expect student population to decrease to about 3000 students in the next three years

- 5. School exceeded growth goals, currently listed with a "B" rating and among top 5% of NC.
- 6. Still continue to see significant deficits is certain sub-group areas.
- 7. Not capturing graduation & proficiency within these sub groups, continued work is needed.
- 8. School has hired a "Graduation Coach" to help students considered "at risk", with their caseload specific to assisting these sub-groups.
