• Infinite Campus is the student information system that is replacing PowerSchool and is the portal to connect to your child's academic world, announcements, assignments, attendance information, grades, your child's schedule, and so much more. ParentSquare is used for school communication, with email, text and app notifications. For parents, it
automatically generates an account, using your email address and phone number. Access your account to
download the mobile app and update your preferences on when and how you are notified. For Students, it is

Transportation: Buses drop off and pick up in the front circle of the school. Car riders can be dropped off or
picked up in 3 different areas: The front circle of the school ONLY after 7 am or after 2:30 pm (as buses are
there before both times), by the Student Center (SC) building from Colony Road by the tennis courts, or in the

- Attendance: The office is in the back of the main office. Unexcused tardies report to class. If you have an excused tardy, go to the attendance office to drop off a note & get a pass. Parents do not need to accompany the student if they have a note. For early dismissal, stop in the attendance office before school starts with a note (must have the student's name, ID # and a phone # where a parent/guardian can be reached between 7:00 -9:00 AM) to get a pass out of class. If a parent cannot be reached, early dismissal will not be granted. No early dismissals will be granted by phone or email. If a student does not have a note, the parent needs to come to the Attendance office and sign them out. NO EARLY DISMISSALS AFTER 1:45. You can upload reasons for a tardy or absence, including supporting documentation, on Parent Square.
- Chromebooks are given to each student during the first week of school. Students are required to complete the Device Care Course in Canvas before receiving a device. Students should complete prior to the first day of school. Students are assigned a specific Chromebook identifiable by serial number and CMS asset tag number. Students are not encouraged to share devices or chargers. Students should bring their school-issued Chromebook to school every day fully charged. Charges will be incurred for damaged or lost devices. - International Baccalaureate Program (IB): IB for All! IB Middle Years (MYP) for 9th and 10th grade in which all students take some or all IB courses. IB Diploma Program (DP) for 11th and 12th grade. IB Coordinator is Sallie Davis, salliem.davis@cms.k12.nc.us.
- Advanced Placement (AP): Students can take AP courses in all grades. 9th graders can take AP Computer Science Principles. Options increase in grades 10, 11, and 12. 11th/12th graders have the opportunity to participate in the AP Capstone Program which is the Diploma track. Coordinator and Capstone contact is Ms. Allyson Davis, kathryn.davis@cms.k12.nc.us.

- **PE**: All freshmen take one PE class. PE or MPHS shirts are required and will be discussed the 1st week.
- No Lockers: MPHS does not have lockers, bring a sturdy bookbag to carry everything! Consider a water bottle!
- **Cell Phones**: Are allowed on the campus but not used in the classroom. On 7/1/25 House Bill 959 was passed restricting the use of wireless devices during instructional time. MPHS uses a lock box system for all cell phones during instructional time.
- **Lunch**: There are 7 minutes between classes. Lunch is by 3rd block, by building, 4 different time slots, 25 minutes. Eat at the picnic tables, or inside the large or small cafeteria.
